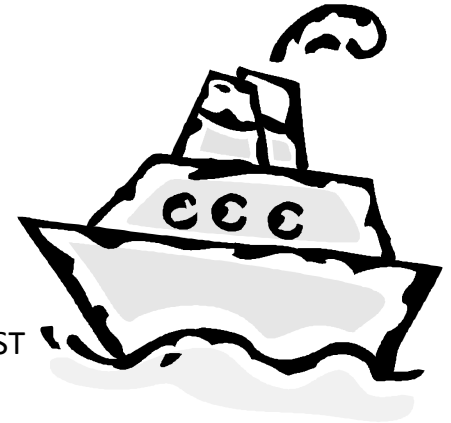

The Great Cardboard Boat Race

AUGUST 8, 2010

THE RULES ARE AS FOLLOWS:



- BUILD THE BOAT AS BIG OR SMALL AS YOU WANT.
- THE OUTSIDE AND INSIDE STRUCTURE OF THE BOAT HULL MUST BE OF CARDBOARD CONSTRUCTION.
- THE HULL MAY BE PAINTED BUT CANNOT BE SEALED WITH ANY TYPE OF WATERPROOF COATING.
- WOOD OR METAL STRUCTURE IS NOT ALLOWED
- THE INSIDE OF THE BOAT CAN BE FILLED WITH BUOYANT MATERIALS.
- THE BOAT MUST BE PADDLED BY ONE OR MORE CREW MEMBERS. NO MOTORS ARE ALLOWED.
- LIFE JACKETS MUST BE WORN BY ALL CREW MEMBERS DURING THE RACE.
- PARTICIPANTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR REMOVING THE REMNANTS OF THEIR CRAFT TO A DESIGNATED RECYCLING BIN.
- PLEASE ADVISE THE CHAMBER OF YOUR INTENTION TO PARTICIPATE SO WE HAVE A SENSE OF NUMBERS.

11:15 A.M. FOR INSPECTION AND MEDIA PICTURES.
